

OJesus commanded baptism

- OJesus commanded baptism by His absolute authority (v. 18)
 - We cannot dismiss what Jesus said
 - OBaptism is involved in "making disciples"
 - Legitimacy and loyalty is in Christ alone
- Now I mean this, that each one of you is saying, "I am with Paul," or "I am with Apollos," or "I am with Cephas," or "I am with Christ." ¹³ Has Christ been divided? Paul was not crucified for you, was he? Or were you baptized in the name of Paul? (I Corinthians I:12-13)



OBaptism involves calling on Jesus' name (compare Acts 2:21, 38)

⁹ that if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved... ¹³ for "EVERYONE WHO CALLS ON THE NAME OF THE LORD WILL BE SAVED." (Romans 10:9, 13)
