Be Courageous

- To embrace responsibility
 - God promised to be with him Joshua 1:5, 9
 - Leadership means responsibility!
 - "Be strong and courageous" Joshua 1:6, 7, 9, 18

Be Courageous

- To follow God's instructions
 - Against Jericho Joshua 5:13-15, 6:1-5
 - Even when they seem counter-intuitive, are unpopular, or open you up to ridicule

Be Courageous

- To face bigger opponents than you
 - An army as numerous as sand Joshua 11:4-6
 - Satan attacks churches with persecution, worldly influences, or complacency – Revelation 2-3

Be Careful

- To obey God's word personally
 - Leaders lead themselves first Joshua 1:7-8
 - Leaders' lives are examples 1 Timothy 4:12, 1 Peter 5:3

Be Careful

- To confront sin directly
 - Joshua addressed Achan's sin Joshua 7
 - Shepherds must confront error Titus 1:9-11

Be Careful

- To make God-honoring decisions
 - Joshua failed to consult God Joshua 9:14-15
 - Shepherd have God's Word, prayer, and others to help guide their decisions
