2. Take Up Your Cross Daily Life's ordinary hardships? Literally? (Colossians 2:23) Die to self / live for Christ! I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me.

Galatians 2:20

...persecuted, but not abandoned; struck down, but not destroyed; always carrying around in the body the dying of Jesus, so that the life of Jesus may also be revealed in our body.

2 Corinthians 4:9~10

...and He died for all, so that those who live would no longer live for themselves, but for Him who died and rose on their behalf.

### 2 Corinthians 5:15

...Christ will even now, as always, be exalted in my body, whether by life or by death. For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain.
