#### Tradition

- Neutral "an inherited, established, or customary pattern of thought, action, or behavior" (Webster)
- Common Usage "a doctrine believed to have divine authority, though not in the scriptures" (Oxford – def. 2)
- Two Questions
  - On whose authority is it based?
  - ▶ Is it exercised within or outside God's authority?
