# Unsatisfied with Jesus

*Luke 11:29-32*

- Jesus' miracles weren't enough!  
(v. 29)
- Gentiles more faithful than Jews  
(Luke 4:25-27, 10:13-16)
- Why did the Ninevites listen to Jonah?



# Unclean Hearts

*Luke 11:37-44*

- “Woe to you!” (6x)
- They tithed but showed no mercy or loyalty to God (v. 41-42, Micah 6:8)
- They craved attention and fed their ego (v. 43-44)



# Self-Deceived

*Luke 11:45-52*

- Their teaching was burdensome and harmful (v. 46, 52)
- They didn't listen to God's prophets (v. 47-51)
- Do not be deceived (1 Corinthians 15:33, Galatians 6:7, James 3:14)
