# Three Kinds of CONFESSION

<sup>13</sup> He who conceals his transgressions will not prosper,
 But he who confesses and forsakes *them* will find compassion.

Is it unhealthy for us? Matthew 6:12

Confession can be general or specific, but never a mere formality
