No "one-size-fits-all" approach (see Jude 22)



Admonish the Unruly

- Compare 2 Thessalonians 3:6-15
 - *Lazy busybodies* (v. 6, 11)
 - Strong words and action required
- Paul's example
 - This is what Jesus says (v. 6, 12)
 - This is the apostles' example (v. 7-9)
 - These are the consequences (v. 10, 14)



Encourage the Fainthearted

- The discouraged in Isaiah
 - *Anxious heart (35:3-4)*
 - *Grieved widow (54:6-8)*
 - *Lowly spirit* (57:15)
- The fainthearted need hope and God's promise
 - 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18



Help the Weak

- Spiritual sickness that weakens faith
 - Deceived by trials (1 Thessalonians 3:1-5, Hebrews 12:12-13)
 - Captured by temptation (1 Thessalonians 4:2-8)
- Help and support them while they heal
 - *Galatians* 6:1-2



Be Patient with Everyone

Seek that no one repays another with evil for evil, but always seek after that which is good for one another and for all people.

1 Thessalonians 5:15 NASB95
