

Context Micah 1:1


• Jotham – good king, wicked people (2 Chron. 27:2, 6)

Ahaz – wicked king (2 Chron. 28:19, 25)

Hezekiah – massive reforms (2 Chron. 29-32)

Samaria and Jerusalem – two wicked capitals

The people who rebel (verses 5-7)

 Application: we should learn from others' sins / judgments (Galatians 6:7)
