Romans 2



The Judgmental Jew

Romans 2:1-4, 21-24

- A condemnation of others that is blind to its own condemnation
- Thinking he can escape God's judgment (v. 3, Luke 18:11-12)
- Thinking lightly of God's grace (v. 4, Deut. 7:7-8, 9:4-5)
- Jesus warned too! (Matthew 7:1-5)

The Righteous Judge

Romans 2:5-16

- We don't have the right to judge, but God does. And He will!
- His judgment is just (v. 2)
- His judgment is inescapable (v. 3)
- His judgment is impartial (v. 11)
- His judgment will bring wrath (v. 5,8, 1:18)





The Pride Problem

Romans 2:17-20

- In our heritage (v. 17)
- In our knowledge (v. 18, 1 Cor. 8:1)
- In our status (v. 19-20, Matt. 5:13-16)

If the problem is a “stubborn & unrepentant heart” (v. 5), the solution is a humble and penitent heart!
