 - Acts 14:15-17
 - Acts 17:27-28

We Worship Something Else Romans 1:22-23, 25

- A not-so-great exchange
 - God's permanent glory for corruptible images (v. 23)
 - God's truth for a lie (v. 25)
- Creation worship has many forms
 - Colossians 3:5, Philippians 3:19
 - Things we want
 - People we love
 - Ideas we believe



We Lose Our Identity Romans 1:26-27

- God created us, our gender and sexuality
 - Genesis 1:27, 2:24-25
 - Another not-so-great exchange (v. 26)
- "You are your sexuality" is a lie
 - You don't create identity, God already has
 - Your identity is "created in God's image"
- Same-sex marriage <u>and</u> behavior are excluded from God's skillful design



We Destroy Ourselves Romans 1:28-32

- Attitudes and behaviors which destroy
 - Greed / envy destroys happiness
 - Murder destroys life
 - Deceit destroys truth and trust
 - Disobedience destroys authority
 - Pride destroys humility
 - Hate destroys mercy and compassion
