Samuel said to Saul, "You have acted foolishly; you have not kept the commandment of the LORD your God, which He commanded you, for now the LORD would have established your kingdom over Israel forever...

...But now your kingdom shall not endure. The LORD has sought out for Himself a man after His own heart, and the LORD has appointed him as ruler over His people, because you have not kept what the LORD commanded you."

God's Chosen Leaders

- Obedience to God
 - Saul was rebellious and disobedient –
 1 Samuel 13:13-14
 - David would do all God's will Acts 13:21-22

God's Chosen Leaders

After He had removed him, He raised up David to be their king, concerning whom He also testified and said, 'I HAVE FOUND DAVID the son of Jesse, A MAN AFTER MY HEART, who will do all My will.'

• Like-minded with God

• Jonathan's body-guard – **1 Samuel 14:7**

His armor bearer said to him, "Do all that is in your heart; turn yourself, and here I am with you according to your desire."

God's Chosen Leaders DAVID

- Like-minded with God
 - Jonathan's body-guard **1 Samuel 14:7**
 - David conformed his heart to God's!

God's Chosen Leaders

Teach me Your way, LORD, and I will live by your truth. Give me an undivided mind to fear your name. **Psalm 86:11 CSB**

God's Chosen Leaders

• Whole-hearted devotion to God

 David became the standard for all Judah's kings – 1 Kings 9:4, 11:4

As for you, if you will walk before Me as your father David walked, in integrity of heart and uprightness, doing according to all that I have commanded you *and* will keep My statutes and My ordinances...

God's Chosen Leaders

• Whole-hearted devotion to God

• David became the standard for all Judah's kings – **1 Kings 9:4, 11:4**

For when Solomon was old, his wives turned his heart away after other gods; and his heart was not wholly devoted to the LORD his God, as the heart of David his father *had been*.

• Whole-hearted devotion to God

- David became the standard for all Judah's kings 1 Kings 9:4, 11:4
- He is an example for godly leaders today Jeremiah 3:15

God's Chosen Leaders

"Then I will give you shepherds after My own heart, who will feed you on knowledge and understanding.

• Concern for God's honor, not your own

 Saul worried about what people thought of him – 1 Samuel 15:30

Then he said, "I have sinned; *but* please honor me now before the elders of my people and before Israel, and go back with me, that I may worship the LORD your God."

God's Chosen Leaders

• Concern for God's honor, not your own

- Saul worried about what people thought of him – 1 Samuel 15:30
- David was motivated by God's name being dishonored – 1 Samuel 17
- Leaders have a heart for God's honor

God's Chosen Leaders

And he must have a good reputation with those outside *the church*, so that he will not fall into reproach and the snare of the devil. **1 Timothy 3:7**

• Concern for God's honor, not your own

- Saul worried about what people thought of him – 1 Samuel 15:30
- David was motivated by God's name being dishonored – 1 Samuel 17
- Leaders have a heart for God's honor

They profess to know God, but by their deeds they deny Him, being detestable and disobedient and worthless for any good deed. *Titus 1:16*

God's Chosen Leaders

• Character of respect for God's plans

- Saul tried to kill David **1 Samuel 18-31**
- David refused to kill the LORD's anointed 1 Samuel 24:6, 26:11

So he said to his men, "Far be it from me because of the LORD that I should do this thing to my lord, the LORD's anointed, to stretch out my hand against him, since he is the LORD's anointed."

• Character of respect for God's plans

- Saul tried to kill David **1 Samuel 18-31**
- David refused to kill the LORD's anointed 1 Samuel 24:6, 26:11
- Leaders don't follow their hearts but God's

There is a way *which seems* right to a man, But its end is the way of death. *Proverbs* 14:12

God's Chosen Leaders DAVID

• Conviction to confess sin honestly

- Saul justified his sin and confessed reluctantly – **1 Samuel 15**
- David confessed openly 2 Samuel 12:13

Search me, O God, and know my heart; Try me and know my anxious thoughts. And see if there be any hurtful way in me, And lead me in the everlasting way. *Psalm 139:23-24*

God's Chosen Leaders

"Then I will give you shepherds after My own heart, who will feed you on knowledge and understanding. *Jeremiah 3:15*

God's Chosen Leaders

And He gave some *as* apostles, and some *as* prophets, and some *as* evangelists, and some *as* pastors and teachers, for the equipping of the saints for the work of service... *Ephesians 4:11*

Shepherds after God's own heart must first know God; only then they can lead others to know God.
